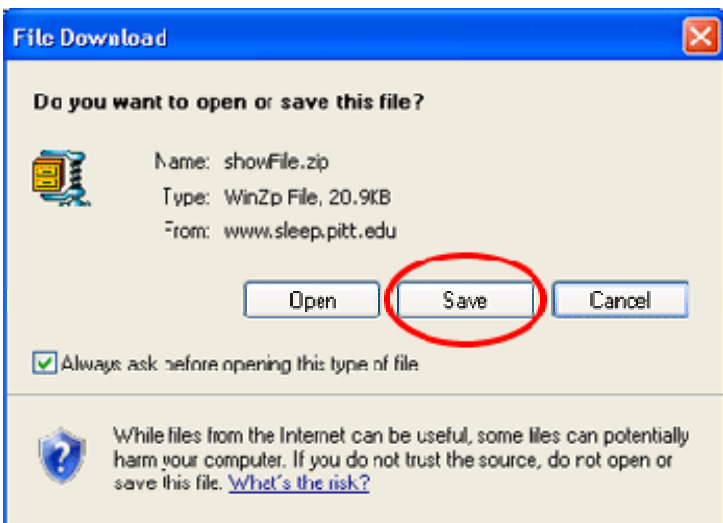


INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOWNLOADING PSQI SCORING DATABASE

Note: The *PSQI Scoring Database* is a Microsoft Access database. You must have Access on your computer in order to open the database. The database is saved in a .zip file. To use, the file must be downloaded, saved, and extracted to open in Microsoft Access.

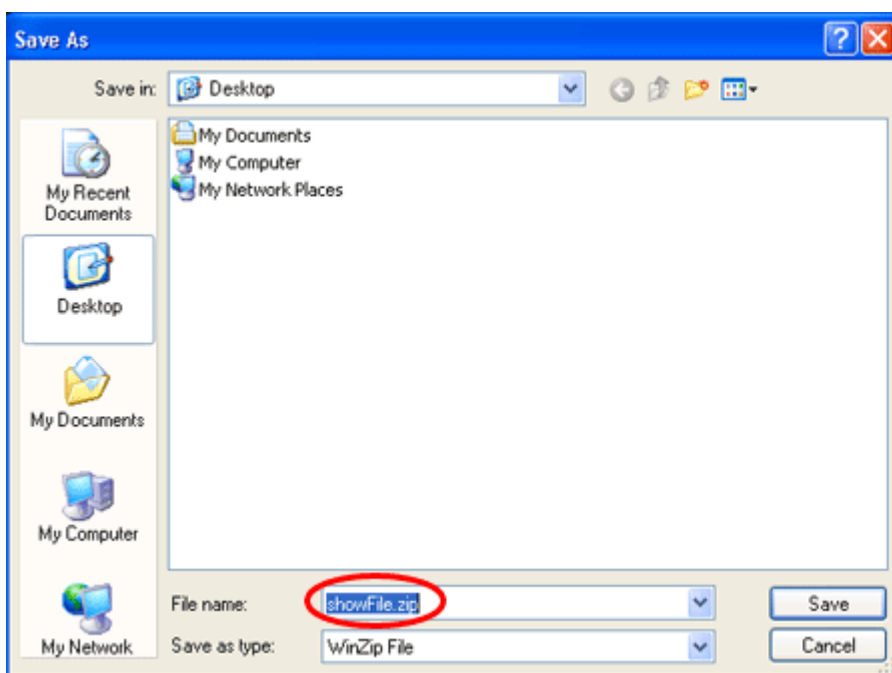

"PSQI Scoring Database" link.

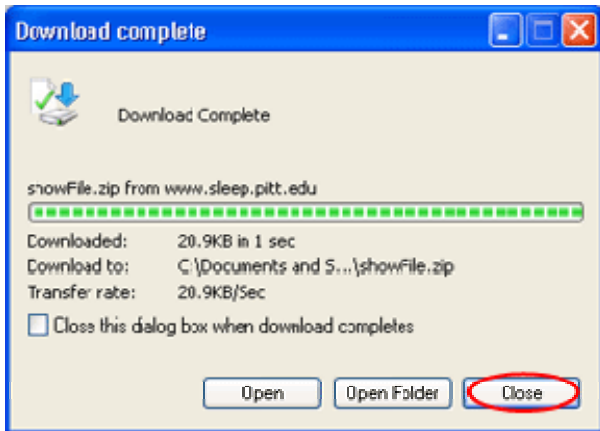


A window similar to this

Click "Save."

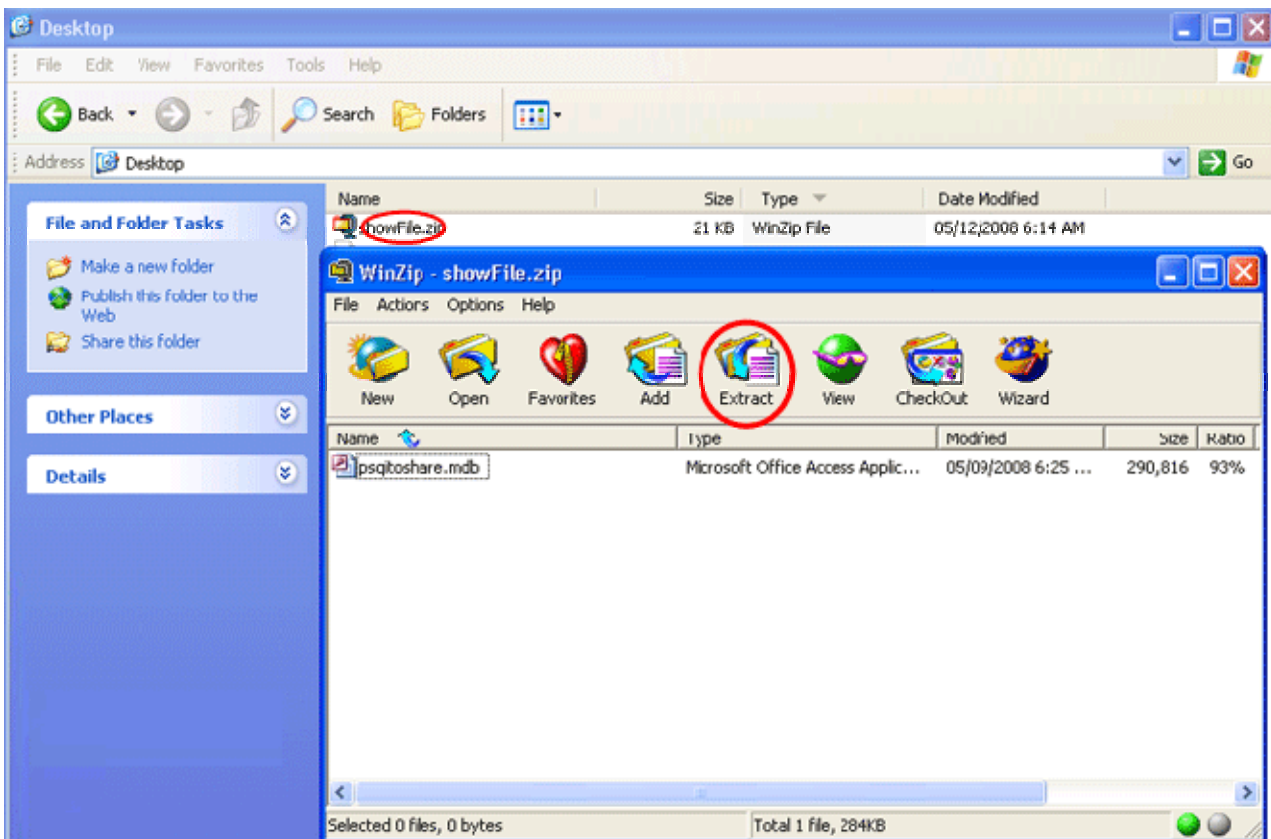


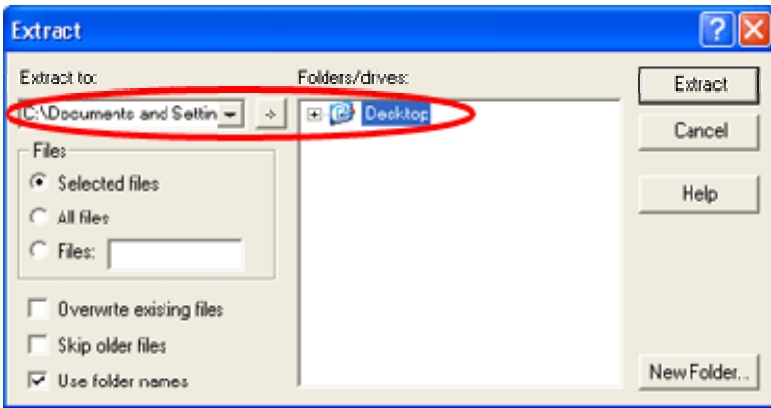
Choose location and

Click "Save."



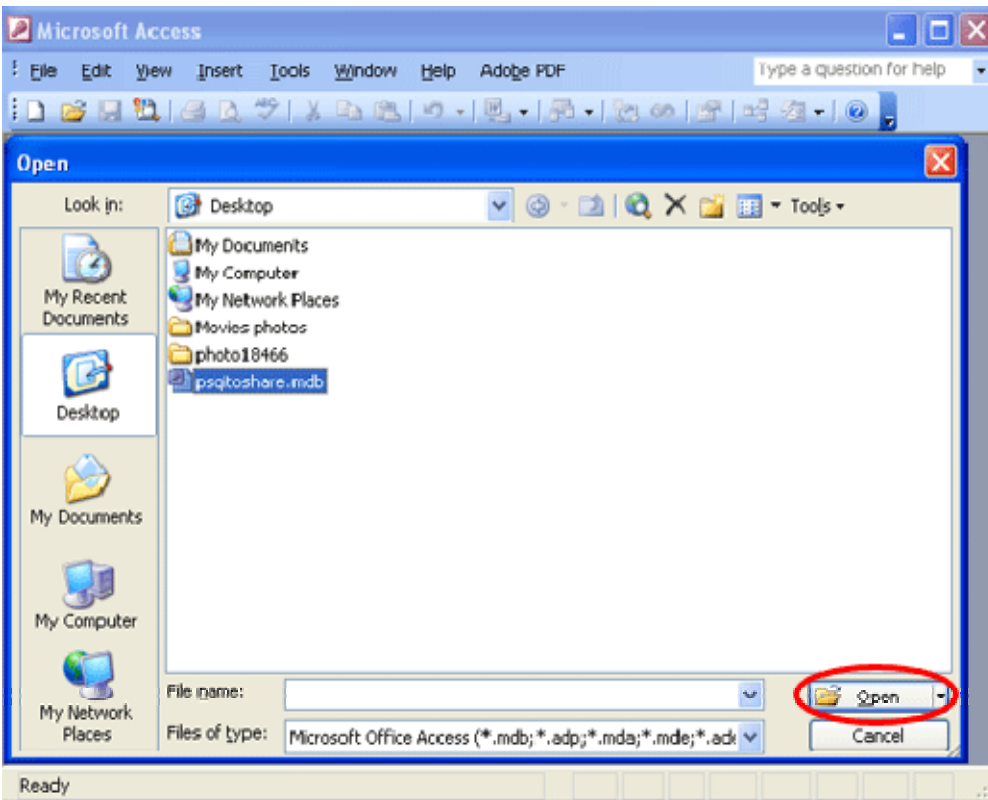
When file download is complete, click "Close."

To extract .zip file, go to "My Computer." Locate file and double click. The "WinZip" window will appear. Click "Extract."

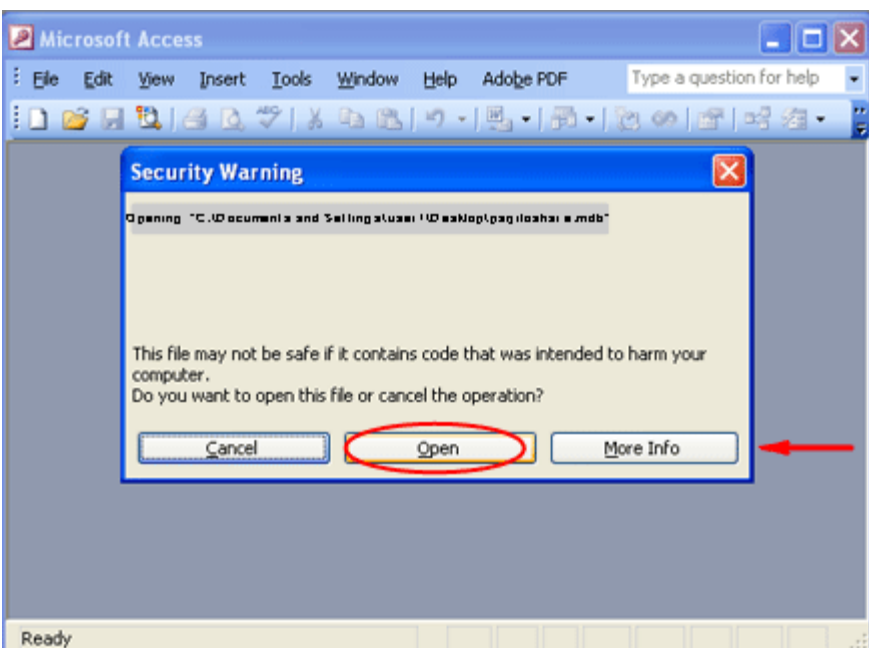




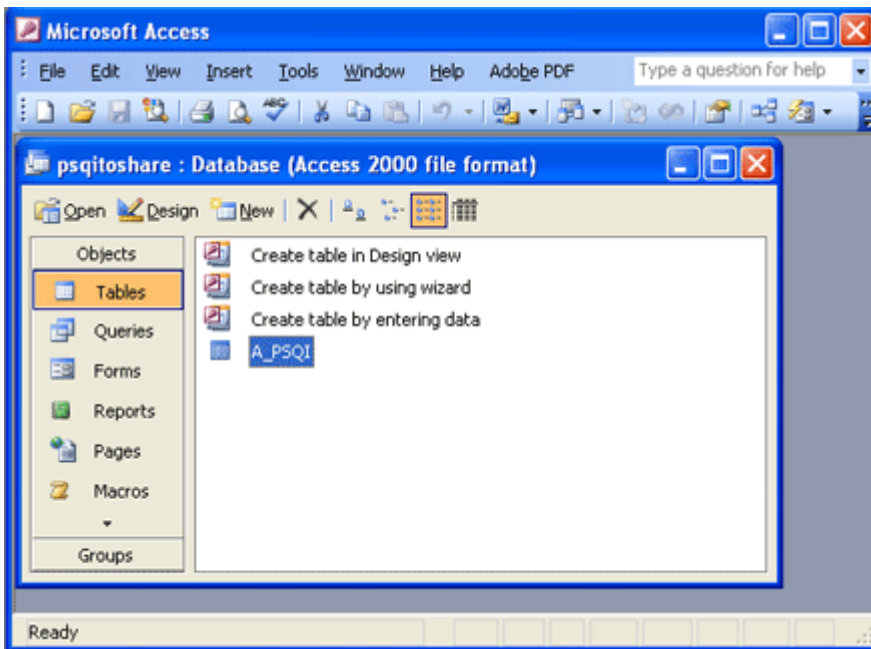
Choose a location where you would like to save the Access database and click "Extract."



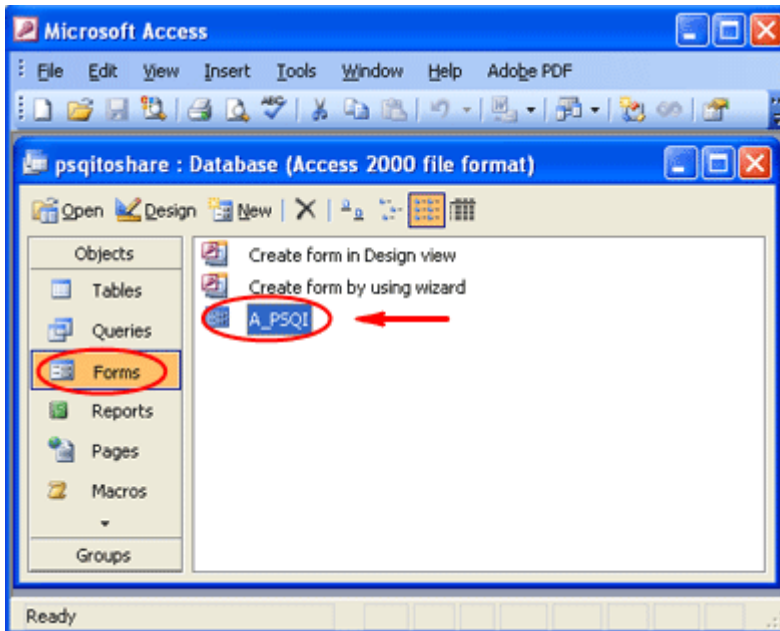
Open the Microsoft Access application and locate saved database and click "Open."

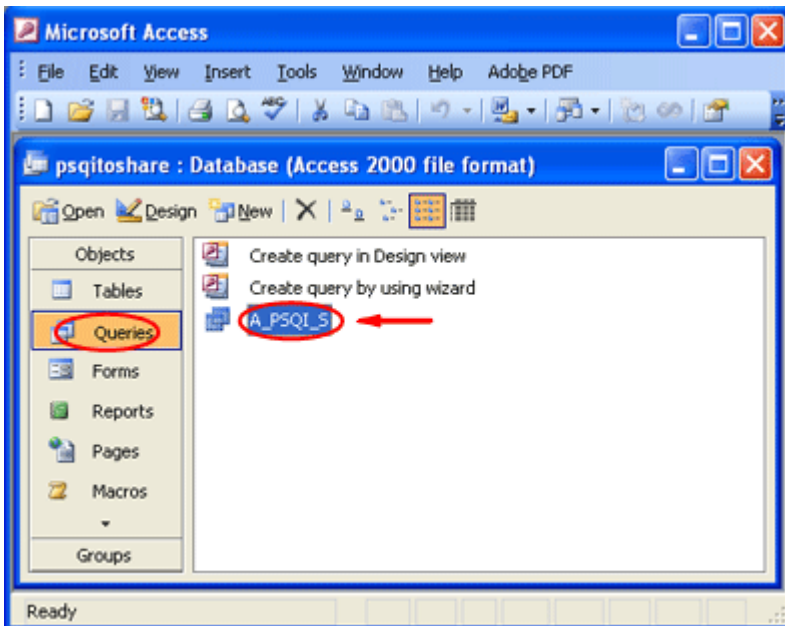

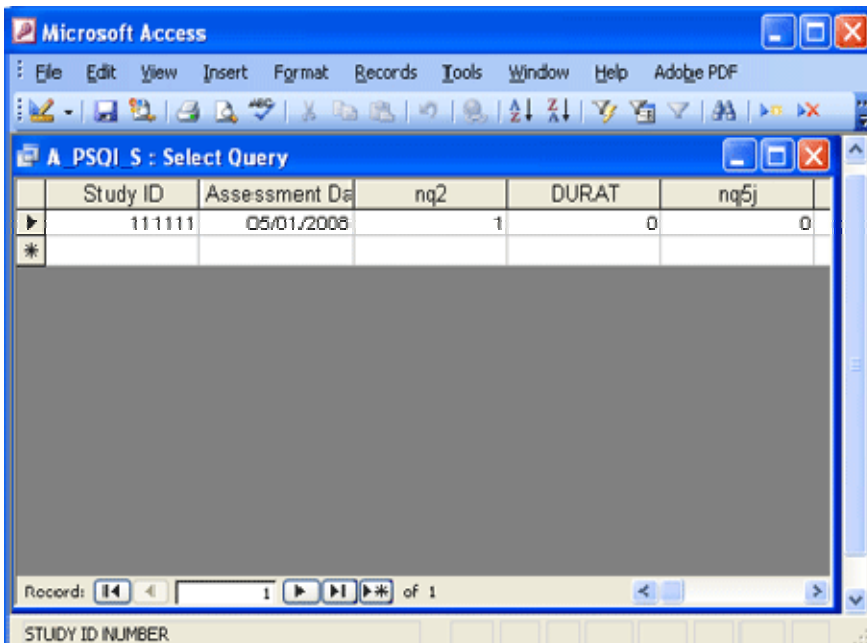
