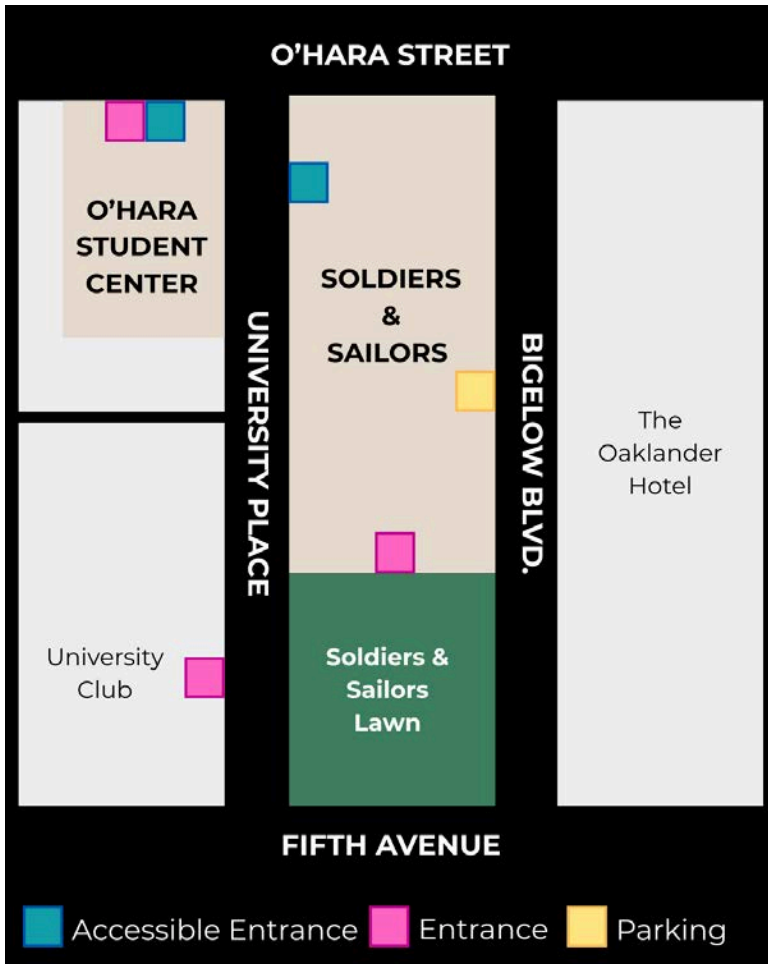

## Venue Layout

### Accessible Entrances (see map)

- Soldiers & Sailors: University Place
- O'Hara Student Center: O'Hara Street

### Elevators

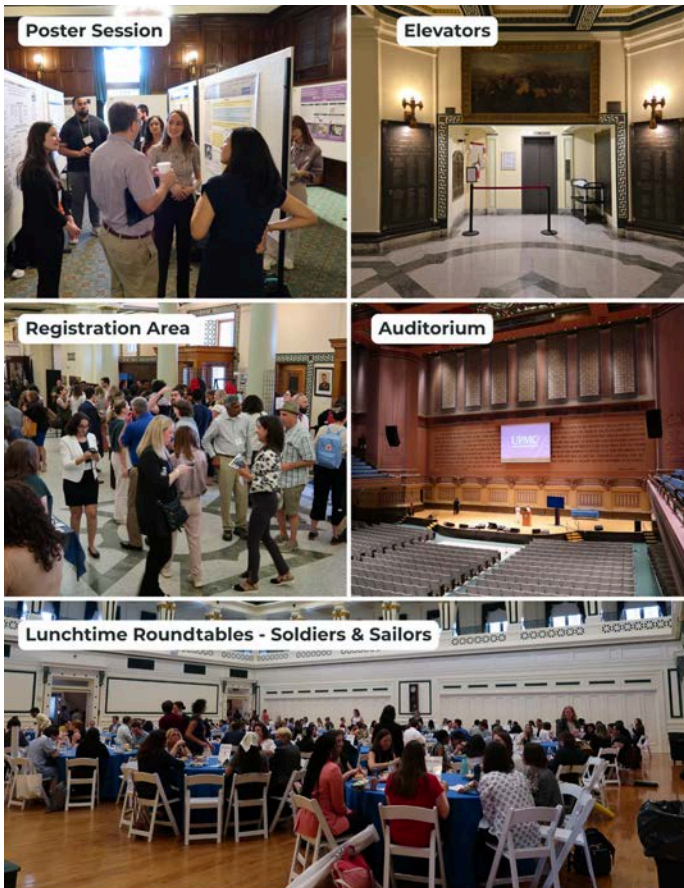
- Elevators located on either side of main lobby.
- Those with physical limitations may prefer using the elevator to access the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> floor at O'Hara Student Center is accessible by elevator (location of some lunchtime roundtables).

### Restrooms

- Lower Level & 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. Accessible restrooms for people with disabilities: 3<sup>rd</sup> floor (use elevator).
- Single occupancy restrooms available in O'Hara Student Center (2<sup>nd</sup> floor) & University Club.

### Parking

- Use metered street parking or the Soldiers & Sailors public garage on Bigelow Blvd (see map).

### Lower Level

### Ground Floor

Main lobby, Registration desk, Elevators, Water fountains, Poster session, Auditorium, Story Corps booth

### 3rd Floor

Accessible restrooms for people with disabilities, Water fountains, Lunch pick-up, Some roundtables

## What to Expect & Useful Tips

---

### Crowds / Lines

- Please note that the poster session gets crowded, particularly later in the morning.
- Please be mindful when stopping to chat in main thoroughfares, as some individuals may need additional space to maneuver.

### Seating

- Accessible seating for the plenary session is available in the rear section of the auditorium, to the right or left.

### Pronoun Stickers

- Name badge pronoun stickers are available at the registration desk.

## Sensory Considerations

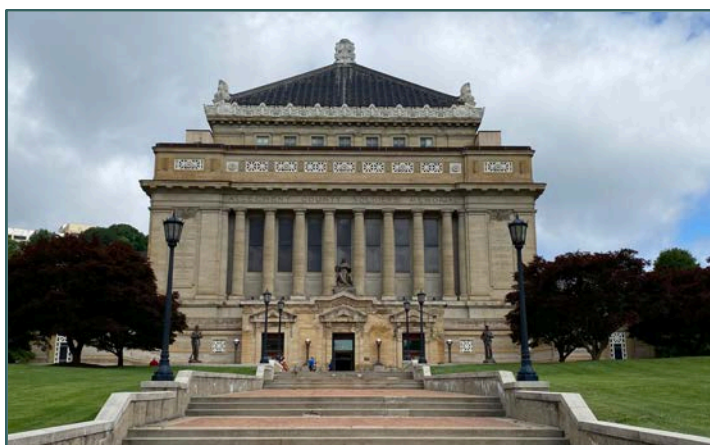

### Volume/Hearing During Poster Session

- For those with noise sensitivity, please note that the poster session can be loud. Ear plugs to filter noise are available at registration.

### Temperature

- Some rooms can get warm. Consider dressing in layers.



## Need Help? FAQs

### Where can I take a short break?

- The back of the auditorium can serve as a quieter space during the morning. Additional options include space outside (weather permitting), as well as the seating behind the Soldiers & Sailors welcome desk (main lobby).

### How do I access the lactation space?

- Please inquire at the Research Day registration desk.

### Where do I get my lunch?

- If you have a roundtable assignment, go directly to your table. Your lunch will be waiting for you on the table.

### Where is my lunchtime roundtable?

- Check the back of your nametag for your roundtable assignment, location, and your lunch order.
- Roundtables will be held on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor of Soldiers & Sailors and the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the O'Hara Student Center. Elevators are available at both locations.

### Where can I pick up my lunch if I'm not participating in a roundtable?

- If you requested a lunch but are not assigned to a roundtable, go to the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of the O'Hara Student Center to get your lunch and find a seat.
