## Research Review Committee (RRC) Department of Psychiatry Policy on PRIME-the-R

## A. Goals of the Policy

• To provide a process that helps junior faculty members receive departmental pilot funding to support their first R series grant.

## **B. Policy Statement**

The Department of Psychiatry has access to foundation funds to support pilot research data collection for early-stage investigators' initial R applications. The Department will conduct scientific review to determine if the pilot project proposal is meritorious. The applications for this "Prime-the-R" program are intended to be short. Similarly, review comments are intended to be brief, simply highlighting major strengths and weakness sufficient to support a confidential funding recommendation. Reviewers will offer one of the following recommendations:

- Fund the pilot study as described
- Revise and reconsider the proposal
- Do not recommend funding of the pilot study

## C. Research Review Committee Process for Prime-the-R

- 1. The process for review of Prime-the-R applications is intended to be simple and rapid.
- 2. The Principal Investigator will identify 3-5 mid-senior level Department faculty members to serve as a reviewer.
- 3. The RRC chair and/or administrator will invite the identified reviewers to review.
- 4. The proposals will include Specific Aims, a brief description of proposed methods, and how the data will help to support a subsequent R application. The Prime-the-R reviewers will complete brief review comments, consisting of a single paragraph of major strengths and weaknesses.
- 5. The reviewers will return their review and recommendation within five business days to the RRC chair and administrator. Brief comments on the following areas would be most pertinent:
- Significance
- Innovation
- Approach
- Likelihood of producing meaningful pilot data
- 6. Dr. Lewis will make final decisions on funding.
